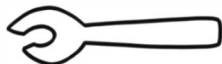
The tools below are all mixed up with the wrong jobs.  
Draw a line from each tool to the job that they help us to do.



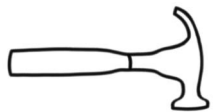
Painting the front door
