









New Life Butterfly Craft

	<p>You will need: Paper, a clothes peg, scissors, glue. Either used patterned paper for the butterfly or decorate plain paper. Here I have used paper that is printed with a pattern on one side and is blank on the other.</p>
	<p>Place the peg on the paper and draw around it to make the butterfly's body. Draw wings too.</p>
	<p>Cut the butterfly out. Fold outwards along the lines of the butterfly's body.</p>
	<p>When you turn the butterfly over to the front, the wings will be sticking up.</p>
	<p>Cut 2 strips of paper, shorter than the length of your butterfly shape. See picture for approximate proportions.</p>
	<p>Turn the butterfly back over and stick the peg to the body section (see photo). Next, stick one end of a paper strip to the underneath of the peg and the other end of the strip to the underside of a wing.</p>
	<p>Make sure only the end of the strip is stuck to the wing, so there is space for movement. Repeat with the other strip and the other wing</p>
	<p>Turn the butterfly over and open and close the peg to watch the butterfly's wings flapping!</p>
