Nazareth, walk!

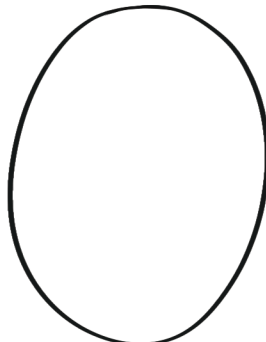
Immediately the beggar was healed and could jump and run!
